

## **VISITOR REGULATIONS**

### **of Archeopark Pavlov**

a branch of the Regional Museum in Mikulov

To ensure the smooth and uninterrupted operation of the exhibition spaces, visitor regulations have been established and are binding for all visitors. Compliance with these visitor regulations ensures the safe and uninterrupted operation of the exhibition and the protection of the displayed exhibits. Following these visitor regulations is also in your own interest.

1. Unless indicated otherwise, the exhibition spaces are open to the public:

**April, October, and November: | 9:00 AM–4:00 PM | Friday–Sunday**

**May, June, and September | 9:00 AM–5:00 PM | Tuesday–Sunday**

**July and August | 9:00 AM–6:00 PM | Tuesday–Sunday**

2. The cash desk of the Archeopark opens on visiting days at 9:00 AM.
3. Last admission to the Archeopark exhibition is 30 minutes before closing.
4. The exhibition is self-guided.

Visitors must follow designated routes, information signage, and staff instructions.

5. Guided tours and educational programs can be arranged by prior phone or written request. It is necessary to agree in advance on the exact date and time of the tour or program, as well as the number of participants. If a booked group does not check in at the cash desk at least 15 minutes before the start of the tour or program, the reservation for the tour or program will be canceled.
6. Payment for the tour, including any additional fee for a guide, must be made in advance. Visitors are required to pay an entrance fee, upon which they will receive a ticket.
7. Purchased tickets are non-refundable.
8. Visitors requesting a discounted admission must present the appropriate proof without being asked. The current list of available discounts and discount cards is included in the current price list, which is available at the cash desk or on the museum's website [www.archeoparkpavlov.cz](http://www.archeoparkpavlov.cz).
9. Visitors must retain their ticket throughout their visit to the Archeopark and present it again upon request.

10. Children aged 15 and under may enter the premises only if accompanied by an adult, who is responsible for the children's behavior and their compliance with the visitor regulations.
11. **Organized groups of children and young people** (e.g., school field trips) **must be accompanied at all times by a teacher or other responsible adult** who is responsible for maintaining the group's discipline and ensuring compliance with the visitor regulations.
12. Visitors are required to follow the instructions of the Regional Museum in Mikulov staff. **Visitors who fail to comply with instructions or orders issued in the interest of visitor safety or the protection of the premises, collections, and exhibits may be asked to leave the premises without a refund of the entrance fee.** In addition, visitors risk being subject to penalties under applicable regulations.
13. **In the event of an emergency (e.g., evacuation of the premises), visitors are required to promptly follow the instructions of the Archeopark staff, emergency services, and all safety signage on the premises.**
14. It is prohibited to leave luggage and other items unattended outside of designated areas.
15. **Persons reasonably suspected of being intoxicated or under the influence of drugs are prohibited from entering the Archeopark.**
16. Visitors wearing heavily soiled, improper, or otherwise inappropriate clothing are not permitted to enter the exhibition.
17. Dogs and other animals are not permitted in any part of the Archeopark, even if they are in bags or carriers designed for that purpose. **Assistance dogs are an exception.**
18. Visitors with disabilities who use wheelchairs or canes are permitted to visit subject to the conditions of the exhibition space.
19. Large luggage is not permitted inside the building.
20. Bicycles, scooters, balance bikes, and other vehicles are not permitted inside the exhibition areas. **The ban does not apply to assistive mobility devices (see point 18).**
21. **Smoking and the use of e-cigarettes, heated tobacco products, or other devices intended for smoking or vaping are prohibited inside the Archeopark.**
22. It is prohibited to damage or endanger the premises, the collections, outdoor areas, or any other property in any way.
23. **It is prohibited to touch exhibited objects** and display cases, except for interactive elements, as well as to write or draw on walls and surfaces, scratch into them, or damage them in any way.
24. Visitors may use the interactive elements of the exhibition only in the manner indicated by the information signs or as instructed by the Archeopark staff.

25. It is prohibited to climb onto the roofs of the Archeopark building or to ride on them on a bicycle, scooter, or any other vehicle.
26. Parking outside designated areas, driving on grassy areas, or on the unpaved road in front of the entrance to the Archeopark is prohibited.
27. **Eating inside the building is prohibited, as is entering with ice cream, food, or open beverages.**
28. It is prohibited to operate drones and multicopters in the exhibition spaces.
29. **Photography using a flash**, tripod, selfie stick, or other lighting or auxiliary equipment is prohibited inside the building.
30. Filming and other forms of video recording and audio-visual documentation are prohibited inside the building without prior approval from the building's curator.
31. It is prohibited to use any photographs, videos, or other documentation taken on the premises of the Archeopark for commercial purposes without the express written permission of the management of the Regional Museum in Mikulov.
32. Visitors must notify the cash desk if they need to interrupt their visit; otherwise, their ticket will expire when they leave the premises.
33. If a visitor causes damage by violating these visitor regulations, compensation will be legally enforced.
34. Visitors may submit their requests, compliments, complaints, and comments directly at the Archeopark if a curator is present. In addition, visitors may contact us in writing or by phone:
